Hawai'i Performance Trip: Sample Itinerary



Day 1 -Arrival and Aloha Spirit

- Arrive in Hawai'i and meet your Tour Director. Board your private motor coach.
- Dinner together at a local restaurant.
- Evening stroll along the **Waikiki Beach Walk**, enjoying the local shops and atmosphere.



Day 2 - Pearl Harbor Performance and Historic Sites

- Start your day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit **Pearl Harbor**, including the **USS Arizona Memorial** and **Pearl Harbor Visitor Center**.
- **Public performance at Pearl Harbor**.
- Afternoon visit to **Iolani Palace**, the only royal palace in the United States, for a guided tour.
- Dinner together at a local restaurant.



Day 3 - Polynesian Cultural Experience

- Start your day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Transfer to the **Polynesian Cultural Center** for a full-day cultural experience, exploring the traditions and arts of Polynesia.
- Evening **Ali'i Luau** and "**Breath of Life**" show, featuring traditional Hawaiian food and live performances.



Day 4 - Master Class and Marine Life

- Start your day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Morning **glass-bottom boat cruise**, observing marine life and scenic views of the O'ahu coastline.
- Participate in a **Master Class** at the University of Hawai'i.
- Free time to explore **Ala Moana Center**, Hawaii's largest open-air shopping mall.
- Dinner together at a local restaurant.



Day 5 - Sightseeing and Live Entertainment

- Start your day with breakfast at the hotel.
- Morning hike at **Diamond Head State Monument**, taking in panoramic views of Honolulu.
- Afternoon visit to **The Bishop Museum** to learn about Hawaiian culture, history, and natural science (if time permits)
- Depart for home.
